Graduates of unaccredited but state-approved universities are allowed to take the state board examinations after their schools' curricula and academic programs are evaluated by the American Council on Education or California University FCE or any accredited and commissioned curriculum evaluators.

Graduates from foreign universities, colleges as well as graduates of unaccredited U.S. universities and colleges are required to get the United States equivalency degrees of regionally accredited universities and colleges before they can be employed in the United States and obtain their licenses to practice their professions. California University FCE is one of those accredited higher education institutions that grant the United States equivalency degrees.

III. Recognition of California University FCE Evaluation Reports:

California University FCE (californiauniversity.edu.pe) and the American Council on Education (acenet.edu) are accredited to evaluate the curriculum of state-approved universities that apply for regional and national accreditation. This is higher type of credential evaluation. We also validate as transfer credits all of the courses earned from the U.S. Armed Forces Service Schools and from unaccredited state approved universities. We certify these credits as equal to the credits earned from the regionally accredited universities.
